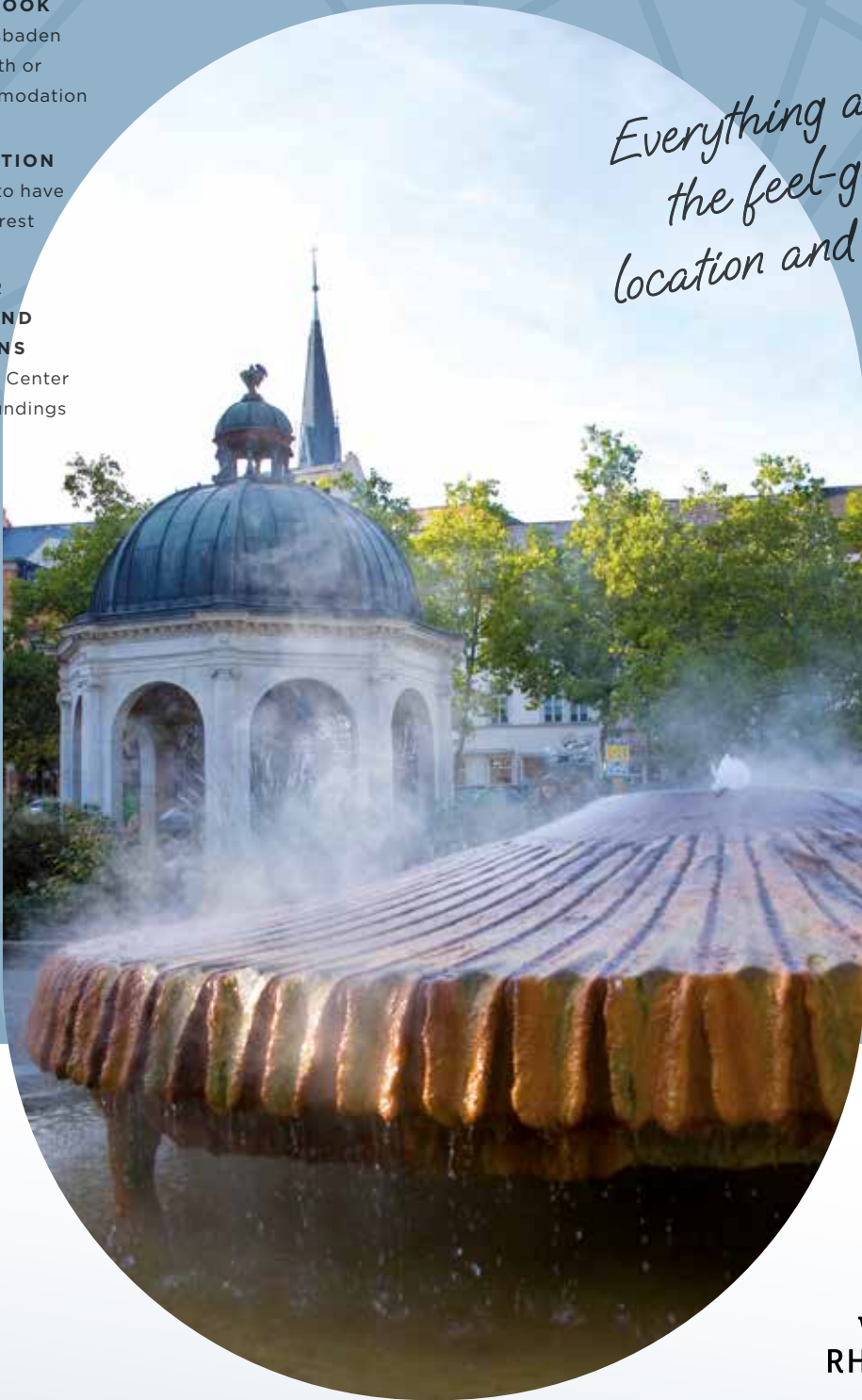

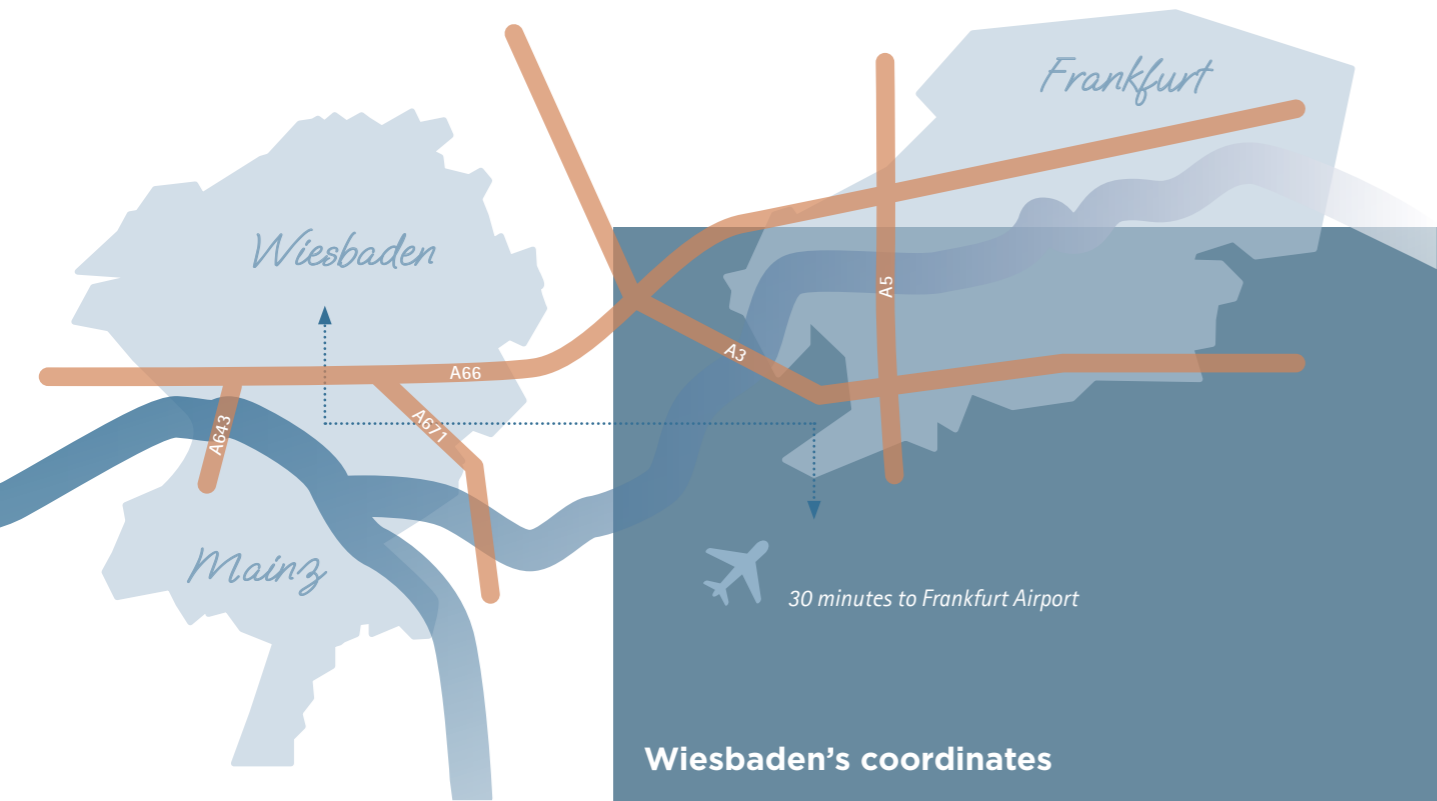

## How to get there



### Wiesbaden's coordinates

Located in the centre of Europe, in the heart of Germany, the state capital of Hesse is one of the largest cities in the culturally and economically vibrant FrankfurtRheinMain metropolitan region. All traffic routes intersect here. Whether by road, rail, or air: Wiesbaden is easily accessible by all means of travel thanks to its extensive connections and its proximity to Frankfurt, the banking metropolis, and with the international airport only 26 kilometres, or 16 miles, away.

### Arrive by coach?

Parking areas designated for coaches are available. There are free bus parking spaces for minibuses and coaches between the centrally located RheinMain CongressCenter and the main railway station. All year round, passengers can get on and off in Paulinenstraße near the Wiesbaden Kurhaus.

### Would you like to use public transport?

The Wiesbaden Card allows you to move comfortably through the city, either in a group or individually.

Even in Wiesbaden's urban area, there is a very natural side to it as slightly more than a quarter of urban space consists of woodland. If you are only looking to visit the city or an event – there are a good many green spaces and parks here, such as Kurpark, the park in the Nerotal valley, Henkell Park, or the grandiose Biebrich palace gardens, which make you forget everyday life for a moment.

The river Rhine with its floodplains and riverside paths is not far away either. All this ensures a good climate and quality of life. You are welcome to take this as an invitation to wind down. The mix of urban and green space makes Wiesbaden a popular starting point for business and city travellers as well as for anyone looking for an activity holiday.

## Pleasant warmth – the thermal springs

Wiesbaden's twenty-six hot thermal springs are a treat for all the senses. The Romans recognised their power as early as 2,000 years ago, and built a settlement here which gradually developed into a popular health resort, and eventually into what is today's Wiesbaden. A bath in the water of these hot springs still proves to be very pleasant, and is used in many therapies.

★ *The city became a prestigious health location that is still recognised today. Wiesbaden therefore hosts numerous events in the medical and pharmaceutical fields.*

## Wiesbaden makes you enjoy the joy of motion

Lace up your running shoes and go for it! For hiking fans, Wiesbaden is quite simply a good starting point to head in any direction. Just try the Rheingoldweg trail from Schierstein if you only wish to take a short walk within the city limits, or to explore the area in all directions, from the Taunus mountain range to the Wispertal valley, should you be looking for a longer route. Or simply walk from the banks of the river Rhine in Biebrich to the Rheinsteig®, a hiking trail covering more than 320 kilometres and boasting fantastic views, a path that really deserves the title of "premium hiking trail". No matter where you are drawn: you will quickly find good regional cuisine!

## Wiesbaden in your ear

All you need is a smartphone – and you can start your tour. And, that much can be promised, an interactive experience tour will introduce you to the attractions of Wiesbaden – both acoustically and visually. While following a route through the city, you are invited to discover and listen to the very different sounds of Wiesbaden at selected stops. Go on a walk, scan the QR codes, and you'll be in for a surprise!

## Neroberg mountain railway – a relaxed ride to the top

In operation since 1888, the Neroberg mountain railway is one of the three oldest water-driven funiculars in the world, and the only one in Germany. Looking at it this way, a real rarity connects the city and Neroberg hill – on no account should visitors to Wiesbaden miss it. After all, on Neroberg, you will be rewarded with a fantastic view, which on a nice day extends as far as Mainz and the Odenwald mountain range.

### Particularly popular: Theatrium/ Wilhelmstraßenfest

The Wiesbaden Theatrium, also known as the Wilhelmstraßenfest, is Germany's largest street festival (and also its oldest). All those who wish to be part of the lively hustle and bustle of the event held in Wilhelmstraße, on the "Bowling Green" in front of the Kurhaus, in Burgstraße, and in the "Am Warmen Damm" park, should be planning their next visit to Wiesbaden during this year's iteration in June 2023.

"Long live freedom, and long live wine!" This toast delivered by Altmayer, the jolly fellow from Goethe's Faust, is appreciated year after year during the Rheingau Wine Festival. Why not find out for yourself: for ten days, the vintners from the Rheingau region offer their specialities at the "longest wine bar in the world" in the heart of the city. Visitors can choose from over 1,000 wines and sparkling wines available for tasting at over a hundred stands, and, of course, a great supporting programme is also part of the Wine Festival.

### Not just for horse lovers: The Whitsun Horse Show

The International Longines Horse Show at Whitsun puts the focus of equestrian sports on Wiesbaden when the world's most renowned dressage riders and show jumpers will be trying their best in the park of Biebrich Palace. Not only lovingly restored horse-drawn carriages promenade here, visitors from all over the world also meet at this high-ranking event. Whether you are a spectator at the four-day tournament, or a guest at the Horse Night, an evening event held in the palace grounds: a visit is always worth your while!

# Celebrating, laughing, letting go

These are complemented by other highlights, for instance the Rheingau Wine Festival in August. Not to forget the Rheingau Music Festival offering first-class concerts at Friedrich von Thiersch Hall in the Kurhaus or open-air events in the concert square in front of the concert shell, summer events at the Brita Arena or, at the end of the year, the Twinkling Star Christmas Market. So no matter when you come to visit our city: Wiesbaden knows how to celebrate and offers different locations for all kinds of events!*

### Christmas magic – the Twinkling Star Christmas Market

What would Advent in Wiesbaden be without its Twinkling Star Christmas Market? This pre-Christmas meeting place featuring light blue huts and an unbelievable number of bright lilies has gained in popularity, and extended far beyond Schlossplatz in recent years: attractions in Mauritiusplatz include the Ferris wheel and the rustic Hessian "WinterStubb" tavern, and Luisenplatz has its own Children's Twinkling Star Christmas Market.

# See for yourself, be amazed, get immersed

The list is long of famous artists who were attracted to Wiesbaden, reflecting our city's high cultural profile. Whether Goethe, who enjoyed a stroll here, Dostoevsky, who left his travel funds in the casino, Richard Wagner, who worked on the "Master-Singers", or Alexej von Jawlensky, who painted in Wiesbaden and stayed until the end of his life: the Hessian state capital has long been a refuge for art, too, and will become even more attractive in the future. The Reinhard Ernst Museum is set to open in 2023, thus complementing the cultural axis that includes within easy walking distance the Murnau Filmtheater cinema, Schlachthof cultural centre, RheinMain CongressCenter, the Hessian State Museum, Nassauischer Kunstverein centre for contemporary art as well as the Literaturhaus Villa Clementine house of literature, the Hessian State Theatre, and the Kurhaus, which is significant in terms of cultural history.

Are you an artist yourself? Do you know the Jagdschloss Platte event location? In the midst of nature, on the edge of the Taunus slope forest, you will find limitless inspiration and the possibility of exclusive exhibitions.

## Curtains up: Theatres, cabarets, and fringe theatres

The annual International May Theatre Festival (30 Apr – 31 May 2023) is without doubt the number one favourite with the public. Make sure to secure tickets in good time. Every two years, the Hessian State Theatre also presents the Theatre Biennial, a very popular format, which, in addition to the stages in the Main Theatre and the Small Theatre, also uses alternative venues and inspires many theatre enthusiasts. If you prefer the cultural programme to be a bit more informal or relaxed: entertainment is provided on unique small and large stages, in charming courtyards or historical villas. There is guaranteed to be something for every taste.

## Reinhard Ernst Museum

The Reinhard Ernst Museum, scheduled to open in the late summer of 2023, is dedicated to showing works from the extensive art collection gathered by businessman Reinhard Ernst. His collection focuses on post-war German and European abstract art, Japanese abstract art as well as American Abstract Expressionism.

## A space for knowledge, fascination, and art – the Museum Wiesbaden

The Museum Wiesbaden boasts a remarkable art collection comprising works by Jawlensky, Beckmann, Schmidt-Rottluff, Liebermann, and Corinth. It also presents a permanent natural science exhibition of fascinating taxidermic mounts including more than 6,000 animals, plants, and fossils. One of the museum's special highlights is the permanent Art Nouveau exhibition. Comprising more than five hundred objects, the collection, a donation by Ferdinand Wolfgang Neess, is characterised by both the extraordinary quality of the works of art and their exceptional art historical importance.

Exciting to know: the concerts are held in cultural monuments such as Eberbach Abbey, Schloss Johannisberg, Schloss Vollrads, in wineries, and at the Kurhaus Wiesbaden.

What inspires our guests is not just the variety of goods offered at the market, but also its special atmosphere, the lively hustle and bustle and, of course, the nice people you meet there.

In the warm season, you are in for a nice surprise up on Neroberg hill: the hidden Château Nero not only offers a magnificent view over the rooftops of Wiesbaden, but also a selected range of wines from Eberbach Abbey. Here you can relax and enjoy wine in the vineyards and get a great view at the same time. In order to make your Wiesbaden experience perfect, we recommend that you arrive in style using the Neroberg mountain railway from the Nerotal valley. However, you may also climb the landmark hill by bike or on foot. Once at the top, keep right on the Löwenterrasse, or terrace of the lions, and a walk along the wall will take you directly to the entrance of the Château Nero. #### Hochheim am Main meets Queen Victoria

The Queen Victoria monument shines brightly among the Hochheim vineyards. The Queen of the United Kingdom herself tasted the Riesling here in the midst of the vineyards in 1845. The Hochheim wine is still delivered to the British Royal Family today.

#### Rudesheim cabin cable car and the famous Niederwald monument

Don't miss the romantic ride in a small cable car cabin up to the Niederwald park. The cabins hover high above. Amazing views included.

#### Enjoy a Rudesheim coffee in Drosselgasse!

The famous little lane with its quaint estate restaurants and wine taverns where music invites you to come in, is unique in the region. It's pure joie de vivre. Don't forget to try an original Rudesheim coffee.

#### Schloss Johannisberg

One of the world's top five wineries and birthplace of the Spätlese, or late harvest wine. Enjoy quality wines and a great view.

#### Eberbach Abbey

Nine hundred years of history, and still going strong. Founded in 1136, Eberbach Abbey has turned into an architectural gem of immeasurable value. The Hessian State Wineries are home to a world-famous vineyard – the Steinberg. One of the most modern wine-growing estates in Europe, the Steinberg cellar is named after the historic vineyard. When visiting the place, a wine tasting is not to be missed.

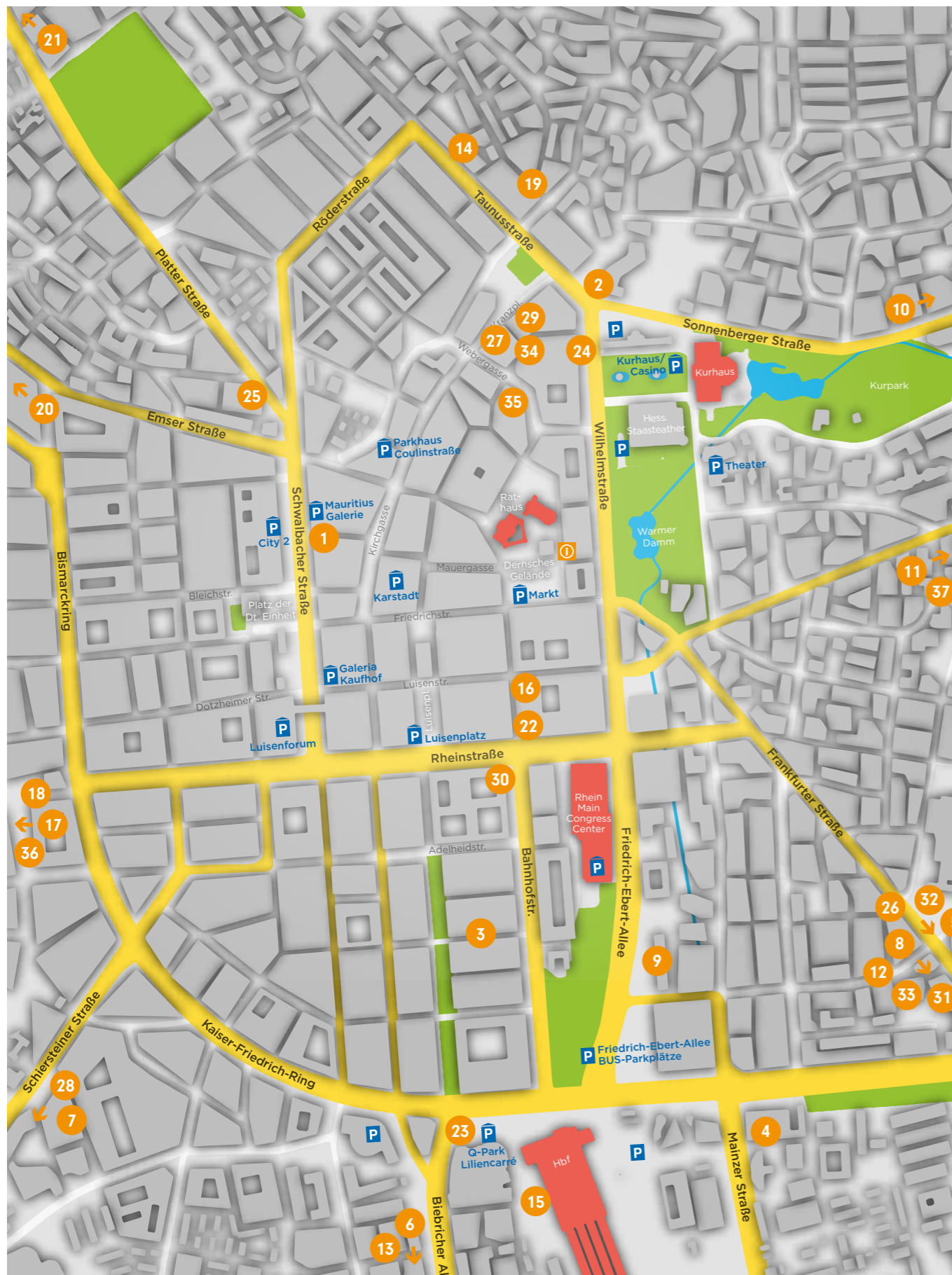

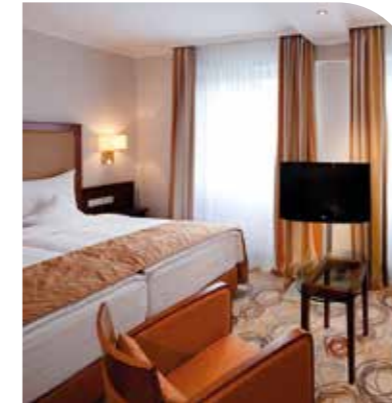

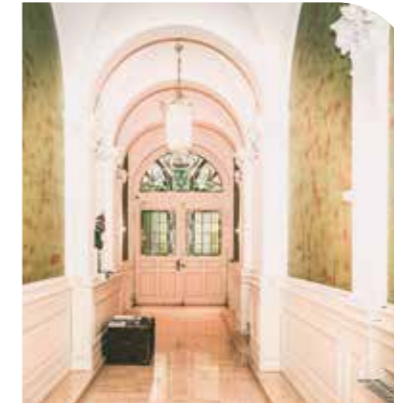
